## Cronachetta anonima delle cose dell'Aquila

(Anonymous Small Chronicle of the Town of L'Aquila)

post 1414. Italy. Annalistic compendium of the chronicles of → Buccio di Ranallo, → Antonio di Buccio and → Niccolò di Borbona. It narrates the history of L'Aquila, in central Italy from 1055 to 1414, but not every year of this period is covered. It contains some new information beyond what

is in the three original chronicles, particularly on the years before the foundation of the town (1055–1253). It survives as a part of a 16th-century manuscript containing copies of privileges: L'Aquila, Archivio di Stato, Archivio Civico Aquilano, V-10, fol. 51<sup>r</sup>–52<sup>v</sup>.
